We're back to New Hope, but with a few new twists. On Tuesday afternoon we'll start with lunch at a food court, then walk across the bridge to Lambertville for a guided walking tour, then dinner before we walk back to our B&B. Wednesday will start with a drive to the Roebling Museum in Roebling, NJ. Roebling wire rope helped make possible some of the most important technological achievements of the industrial age: telegraphs and telephones, electrification, deep mines and big ships, elevators and airplanes. Roebling's cables are part of the Brooklyn Bridge, the George Washington Bridge, and the Golden Gate Bridge. From there we'll drive to Hamilton, NJ where we'll visit the Grounds for Sculpture, enjoying a boxed lunch and then a guided walking tour. Grounds for Sculpture has 270 sculptures by renowned and contemporary artists, each positioned on landscaped parkland full of exotic trees and flowers (and benches). And you can be part of a famous painting. We'll drive back to New Hope and have dinner in Lambertville. Thursday morning will be a tech session or a browse around New Hope, then we'll leave for home.
